

ENC ECE Scholarship Policy and Procedure Policy: ENC will grant a scholarship to all eligible students enrolled in the ECE program of an amount up to \$2500 per financial aid year (prorated to 24 credits). The scholarship will remain in effect for all students who are in the program as of 11/01/13. However, if the student, due to scheduling, cannot access the full amount of the scholarship, the school will continue to offer some form of ECE scholarship. The student must be in good academic standing. There will be a scholarship committee set up by ENC to judge based on these rules. Procedure: The student shall receive the scholarship one semester at a time only after the student has received all other aid that is not a loan. This scholarship is not refundable and the student will not get more money than would go towards his or her educational costs. While the school will make an effort to put the application in the student's possession, it is up to the student to make sure that school receives the signed application. ENC reserves the right not to award the scholarship if proper effort has not been made by the student (such effort as getting their FAFSA in, filling out the scholarship application, following through on needed documentation if selected for verification by the Department of Education, and so forth). For awarding purposes there will be these standards 1. A student will not receive funding from the college that results in a credit balance on their account after the "free" monies are taken into consideration (PELL grant, ECE grant and MassGRANT, etc.) 2. The most a student can get per 3 credit class for 2013-14 will be 312.50 3. The amount of aid will be factored per semester and applied in the second term. 4. Loans taken by the student will not be factored into the application of the ECE scholarship.
